**FRIDAY JUMPING CLASSES**

- 11. Top score jumping-** a random course of jumps from heights 30cm- 1.05m will be assembled. Riders have 2 minutes to gain as many points as they can by jumping jumps of their own choice in any order. Each jump is worth different points- the harder the jump, the more points it is worth. Each jump can be jumped twice, once in each direction. If the jump is

knocked on the first attempt it cannot be jumped a second time in the other direction. No points are gained or lost for jumps that are knocked. Refusals also do not lose any points, however three refusals at the same jump will result in elimination. There will also be a 65cm joker and a 1.05m joker. Riders must select before the start of their round which joker they will be attempting (if any) the joker is worth 100 points. However, if the joker is knocked, the rider loses 100 points. Ribbons will be awarded in two sections -**65cm joker group and 1.05m joker group**. Riders may still jump any available jumps in the course within these groups.

Please note that all the perpetual trophies remain the property of Redlands Stables and remain on display at the riding school. Your name and the year will be engraved on the trophy to record your win. You are welcome to take photographs with your trophy!

What to wear: All riders must wear riding boots and a helmet approved within the current safety standards. We recommend light coloured jodhpurs and the Redlands Stables t-shirt (available to purchase.) Optional gloves, chaps, jumpers. You can also wear pony club uniform. Please no hacking jackets.

**Cost for show is \$100 for 3 days, or \$50 for one day. Children under 8 \$20 for one day or \$50 for 3 days. Lunch and drinks are included. Bookings are essential for use of school horses.**

## Guide to events

**Handler/ presentation:** This is a led event, the horses wear saddles and bridles with stirrups run up. The judge is looking to see who can handle their horse on the ground at the walk and the trot, as well as assessing the overall presentation of the horse and the rider. So, nice clean boots, tidy hair, and a well groomed horse will certainly get you extra points! Practice leading your horse or pony so that it will walk and trot with you by its shoulder. It should be able to walk, trot, halt and turn while you lead it.

**Rider class:** The judge is assessing the position and effectiveness of the rider. The rider should be aiming to keep the best position possible, while also remaining calm and in control of their mount. Depending on your age, you will probably be asked to do a walk, sitting trot, rising trot, canter on both legs and a simple change. But don't worry- the judge certainly won't make you do anything you're not up to yet.

**Versatile/ educated mount:** The judge is assessing the horse or pony in this class and is looking for a mount that is willing, kind, able to give everything a go and show that it is obedient to the rider. You might be asked to do a rein back or bend through some cones.

**Musical freestyle:** Pick a song you like and co-ordinate a matching costume if you wish! You have two minutes to wow the judges doing anything you like. Use your imagination!!

**Fancy dress:** self explanatory although helmets must still be worn.

**Sporting events:** Are very easy to learn. We will show you what to do on the day, and if you're attending camp, you will learn them then.

**Juniors** are under 12 years of age. Seniors are aged 12-17. Adults are 18 and over.

This show is meant to be fun, enjoyable, and a great learning experience for everybody. Please help your fellow riders when you can, and give everyone plenty of encouragement! We love to see cheering, applause, and riders congratulating each other!!!

Riders will be required to sign a waiver before competing. Please print it out and bring to the show. Please do not drop your child off without having arranged payment and signing the waiver.

The judges decision is final.

In the case of wet weather, the show may be postponed. All announcements will be posted on facebook.

We will have jackets and t shirts available for purchase on the day but cannot guarantee sizes. Please order in advance for your guaranteed sizes.

You do not have to attending Redlands Stables to attend the show. All riders are welcome.
